Good healthy communication is impossible without openness, honesty, and vulnerability. I think the number one rule of effective communication should be: 'choose your words wisely'. This is because a simple choice of wording can make a great difference and determine whether your message will be accepted or rejected. If you yell less, regardless of the way that you feel, then you should start seeing that people are more receptive to the things that you are trying to communicate.

When we are fully present, we have access to our greatest power, creativity and ability to communicate and perform exceptionally at whatever we are doing. Talking more than necessary is a barrier to effective communication and effective listening. Effective communicators make great friends. They're open to many things and can translate their thoughts into meaningful words and actions. Communicating socially is an imperative part of our daily lives and relationships, and when we can interpret and interact with the emotions of others, we're able to build stronger relationships, hold more effective meetings with our committees and have a clear direction as to what we are trying to do to complete our goals.
